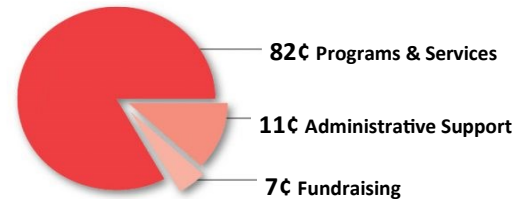

Dinner & Movie! The families enjoyed different movies and dinner with their children each month.

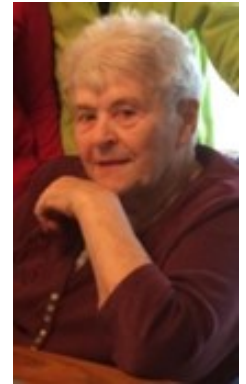
Thursday Night Bible Study
