ABOUT DONUTS

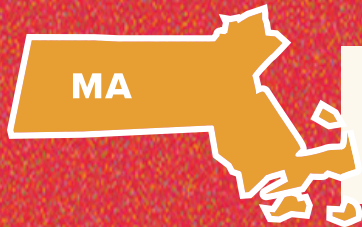
No. 1
