LT. COLONEL STANLEY JAYNES



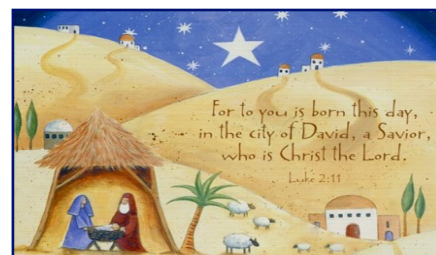
We salute Lt. Colonel Stanley Jaynes, from the "Heroes Of The Faith" session. He was Promoted to Glory on July 18th.

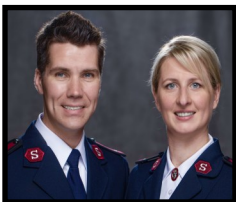
