PROGRAMS & SERVICES



CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Emergency assistance for food, utilities, rent, and prescriptions. Christmas Angel Tree providing toys, clothing, and food. Partners with interchurch Backpack Blitz to provide back to school supplies. Sponsors at-risk youth to day camps at the Corps. Offers weekly worship services, youth programming (character building, Maker's Space), Bible studies, pickleball league, and senior services.

THE SALVATION ARMY THRIFT STORE

Offers a variety of donated goods including clothing, furniture, household items, and electronics. Proceeds from the sales supports local Salvation Army programs while also providing employment opportunities.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, an indoor pool, fishing, high ropes courses, an archery range, and log cabins. Nearly 500 camp experiences are provided to kids and senior adults from across Indiana every summer. Individuals are able to participate in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers, and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional, and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water, and financial assistance at crucial moments.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other drug and alcohol rehabilitation services include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentored 7 families in 2025, teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the "teach a person to fish" component of our mission.

STORY OF HOPE

When Stephanie arrived in the United States from Colombia, she was excited and nervous for a better life ahead. As a mother, her greatest desire was to create safety and opportunities in this unfamiliar country. At a moment when hope felt fragile and the future unclear, The Salvation Army of Bloomington became a lifeline.

Through Pathway of Hope, Stephanie found more than assistance; she found partnership. With the support of caring caseworkers, she began taking concrete steps toward long-term stability. Stephanie participated in financial literacy classes, gaining new tools and confidence to manage her finances and plan for the future. She also secured a higher-paying job, opening the door to greater financial security for her family. Today, Stephanie is doing something she once thought was out of reach: saving to purchase her first home. This goal represents far more than a financial milestone—it is a symbol of safety, dignity, and generational change for her children.

Reflecting on her journey, Stephanie shares that when all hope seemed lost, The Salvation Army stood with her, helping her find her footing in a new country and reminding her that a better future was possible.
