PROGRAMS & SERVICES



CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Provides emergency assistance for Bartholomew County families facing economic challenges. Christmas Angel Tree provides toys, clothing, and food for children. Partnerships provide school supplies. Sponsors at-risk youth to Hidden Falls Camp. VBS and adult and senior programs. Monthly family night at a local restaurant for crafts and Bible study.

SALVATION ARMY FEEDING PROGRAM

Serves prepared meals to 75 to 100 people every week. Some people have nowhere else to turn for a meal. Sponsors and volunteers help support this important ministry.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, high ropes course, archery range and log cabins. Nearly 500 camp experiences are provided to kids and senior adults from across Indiana every summer. Individuals are able to participate in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources, referrals, and transportation for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. A support group is offered at the corps weekly. The Harbor Light Center is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other drug and alcohol rehabilitation services include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers.

BOOTH MANOR

Provides affordable housing options to Senior Citizens with limited resources who are seeking a stable environment. Opportunities are created to help residents build community together. With the corps next door, residents are able to easily connect with additional assistance.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the “teach a person to fish” component of our mission.

STORY OF HOPE

Once a month on senior pantry day Nancy, the social services coordinator for The Salvation Army of Columbus, helps roughly 100 families get the food they need. Even amidst the busyness, Nancy did not miss June on her first visit to the pantry. June was the grandmother of three wonderful boys who just moved in with her. Their mother was no longer able to care for them amidst addiction, and June was so happy to have them in her home, but she was struggling.

June turned to The Salvation Army of Columbus to receive food assistance. Because she was over the age of 55, she learned that she could receive assistance from the food pantry 3 times a month. This assistance would be a lifesaver for her and her three grandsons.

As June went through the pantry for the first time, she saw produce that her grandsons loved that she had been unable to buy for them yet. She began to cry as she realized the joy she could bring the boys through this food she could not afford on her own. The Salvation Army was there to step in for June as she stepped in for her grandkids.
