## PROGRAMS & SERVICES



### GOSHEN CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Provides emergency assistance for families facing economic challenges in Southern Elkhart County. Christmas Adopt-A-Family provides toys, clothing, and food for children. Partnerships provide school supplies. Hosts annual events including Pancake Day, a local favorite, and a Back to School Bash. Weekly worship services, youth, adult and senior programs.

### SENIOR PROGRAM

Provides monthly grocery order of various produce, canned items, and dry goods. Serves hot meals three times a week. Hosts weekly activities including bingo, worksheets, exercise activities, Bible study, crafts, weekly themes, embroidery club, adult VBS, opportunities to go shopping, and many other ways to enrich senior living.

### YOUTH PROGRAMS

Encourages youth through programming each Sunday that focus on character building and spiritual growth, a hot lunch is provided. Through these programs, children learn important life skills such as doing laundry, caring for the environment, and showing love for God and others. We also offer WRAP—Worship Requires Active Participation—a high-energy, interactive worship experience that encourages children to express their faith through movement and song.

### HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, an indoor pool, fishing, high ropes courses, an archery range, and log cabins. Nearly 500 camp experiences are provided to kids and senior adults from across Indiana every summer. Individuals are able to participate in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

### EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water and financial assistance at crucial moments.

### ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other drug and alcohol rehabilitation services include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

## STORY OF HOPE

Chase's children had been receiving Christmas assistance through The Salvation Army of Goshen for many years before he came in for help himself. After a divorce, receiving custody of one child, and some mental health struggles, Chase made the hard decision to turn to The Salvation Army. With all of these changes, at 50 years old, Chase was noticing his declining mental health.

With his mom and support system by his side, Chase walked into The Salvation Army and talked with Gail, the Social Services Director. Gail sat and talked with Chase and quickly had some ideas on how to help. First, she helped him find a local support/recovery community. Next, she helped him get connected to a local energy assistance program, car repair ministry, vocational rehabilitation program, and provided him with food from The Salvation Army food pantry.

Chase was so grateful, he thanked Gail and the team for saving his life. Gail expressed, "this is a reminder of how valuable it is in our daily work to introduce families to the resources that exist in our community." Chase's quality of life has improved since being courageous enough to come to The Salvation Army.
