CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Provides emergency assistance to Henry County residents in need. Food, gifts, and toys for children and families along with gifts of blankets for elderly are provided at Christmas. Hosts weekly worship services, online and in person, Bible studies, youth programming, and character building. The building provides a heating and cooling station during extreme weather. Transportation is provided for appointments, probation, and to shelters in other counties. Additional events and activities are provided such as diaper giveaways, homeschool events, zumba classes, educational classes and an adult basketball league.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the “teach a person to fish” component of our mission.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

700-acre camp near Bedford. Nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, challenge course, archery range and high-quality log cabins. Nearly 500 camp experiences are provided to kids and senior adults from across Indiana every summer. Individuals are able to participate in various camps, focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

SUMMER CARE AND LEARNING

Day camp provides local children with opportunities to develop, mentally, physically, spiritually, and emotionally. Weekly field trips with education to improve learning and decision-making skills that builds the children from being strangers to being friends and ending as a family with Christ centered environment. It makes this a very special time for youths to develop Christian morals.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other drug and alcohol rehabilitation services include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

STORY OF HOPE

Anne needed support and Beth, who runs The Salvation Army of Henry County, showed up just in time and invited her to church.

Anne showed up and never looked back. Anne needed The Salvation Army as she was going through one of the hardest times of her life. With 5 kids to care for, Anne was also facing domestic violence at home. Anne began sharing her struggles with Beth and got signed up for the Pathway of Hope program where she was able to set goals, get her GED, continue working, receive support, and begin to see a way out of her harmful relationship.

Through the program, Anne applied for an affordable apartment that would house her and her children. She had to wait a year for one to become available. Anne had no support system besides her stepmom who did not have the room to take her in.

The Salvation Army and attending church there became her lifeline and her network for friendships. Anne never missed a Sunday. Within the last few months, Anne settled into her new apartment with the children; her divorce was finalized, and she even went on a mission trip to help serve others even amid her struggles. Anne was so thankful for the support from The Salvation Army of Henry County to help her move forward and escape an environment that was unsafe for her and her children.
