PROGRAMS & SERVICES



CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Provides emergency assistance for Howard County families facing economic challenges. Partners with Meijer to manage Christmas food pantry. Distributes donated toys, clothing, toiletries, and small appliances at Christmas to clients to use as gifts for their families. Weekly worship services on Sundays.

THE FOOD PANTRY

Groceries for working families, the hungry, and the homeless, along with spiritual care and encouragement. Collaboration with Sam's Club and Aldi enables more families to receive healthy food.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other drug and alcohol rehabilitation services include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional, and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water, and financial assistance at crucial moments.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, high ropes course, archery range and log cabins. Nearly 500 camp experiences are provided to kids and senior adults from across Indiana every summer. Individuals are able to participate in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the "teach a person to fish" component of our mission.

STORY OF HOPE

Christmas was quickly approaching & the gifts that Susan thought she could buy for her three kids were further out of reach than ever. After a severe car accident, Susan's husband, Dan, was sent over an hour away to a hospital in Indianapolis, where he was placed in an induced coma. With Dan in the hospital, they lost his income, & Susan lost time at work as well, due to driving herself & her children to visit her husband. The money they had been setting aside was quickly dwindling. Susan was overwhelmed, scared, sad, & with Christmas only a few weeks away, mourning the fact that she could not give her children any gifts. She knew that sign-ups for most Christmas assistance had closed long ago, but was hopeful that maybe someone could help. She called The Salvation Army of Kokomo & talked with Jean, the social services coordinator. Due to the generosity of donors, Jean knew that they had some extra gifts, even after providing presents to the individuals who had signed up for their Christmas assistance. Jean was able to gather gifts that were perfect for all three of Susan's children & provide a little light in a dark time. Even amid the struggles & uncertainty that the weeks before had brought, Susan was able to give her children the Christmas they deserved.
