PROGRAMS & SERVICES



CORPS COMMUNITY CENTERS

Provides emergency assistance (food, utilities, rental assistance) for Tippecanoe County families facing economic challenges. Our Tools for Schools, Winter Warm-Up and Angel Tree programs help meet seasonal needs by providing school supplies, winter coats, and new toys and gifts for Christmas. Weekly worship services, youth, adult, and family programs.

YOUTH PROGRAMS

We seek to equip young people with the resources they need to navigate the journey to adulthood. Our “Midweek” program gives students the chance to try new things while growing in social skills, character, and faith. Homework help, makerspace activities, archery, and mentoring are also provided through partnerships with the Purdue College of Education, Tippecanoe County Youth Services, and local STEM educators.

EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional, and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional care, emergency shelter, food, water, and financial assistance at crucial moments.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other drug and alcohol rehabilitation services include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, high ropes course, archery range and log cabins. Nearly 500 camp experiences are provided to kids and senior adults from across Indiana every summer. Individuals are able to participate in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the “teach a person to fish” component of our mission.

The Salvation Army of Lafayette's Pathway of Hope (POH) program offers more than just a handout, it offers, support, encouragement, and a hope for the future. Tayshia, a single mother of three, was behind on rent, facing an eviction, and struggling to keep up with bills with her low-paying job. Andrew began working with Tayshia, connecting her with a financial counselor who helped her use her tax refund to prepay her rent for the next few months.
