How it Works for You:

- 55% Missouri state tax credit for gifts of \$1,000 or more.
- Credits can be carried forward up to 10 years.
- Available to business, taxpayers (corporations, partners, financial institutions, insurance companies, etc.) with Missouri tax liability.
- Donors may also claim their federal charitable deduction in addition to the Missouri state tax credit.
