The Salvation Army Brooklyn Brownsville Corps “Helping Hand” Grant

Overview:

The Salvation Army Brooklyn Brownsville Corps “Helping Hand” Grant is awarded to students graduating from a high school in the Brownsville/East New York Community.

The Salvation Army, an international movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination.

We are the Greater New York Division of The Salvation Army, and for over 130 years, we’ve dedicated ourselves to doing the most good for the men, women and children in our area who need it most.

What is the Helping Hand Grant?

The “Helping Hand” Grant is a one-time award presented to graduating seniors who have consistently shown characteristics of integrity, resilience and service to others, and who will be attending an accredited college, university, community college, technical or trade school.

The primary criteria of this grant are based on students’ attributes and community achievements as communicated by the applicant and supporting recommendations. Graduating students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.3 or higher.

For 2026, the grant amount will be up to \$500.00.

To receive a Helping Hand Grant:

The graduating senior must attend one of the following high schools:

- W.H Maxwell Career and Technical Education
- Fredrick Douglas Academy VIII
- Brownsville Academy
- Teacher’s Preparatory
- Thomas Jefferson Educational Campus:
 - Performing Arts and Technology
 - World Academy for Total Community Health
 - FDNY High School for Fire and Life Safety
 - High School For Civil Rights

Each student must provide a completed application and two required recommendations by the stated application deadline.

The Helping Hand Grant selection committee will evaluate all qualified applicants. The decision will be based on information obtained from the applications submitted and, if deemed needed, discussions with the applicant(s). The decision of the selection committee will be final.

The award recipient(s) must submit proof of acceptance to an accredited college, university, community college, technical or trade school. Proof of acceptance, (i.e.; Bursar’s registration bill, school housing receipt, or other official documents) will be required to receive the grant award.



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Help Hand Grant Application Instructions

Eligible students must complete and submit all required forms by the announced deadline date by taking the following steps:

Step 1: Student must complete the Application Form

Using the APPLICATION FORM in this application, the student must neatly complete and sent it by either:

Step 2: Obtain two (2) Personal Recommendations and include with Application Form

Using the PERSONAL RECOMMENDATION FORMS included in this application, the student must obtain two (2) recommendations. The recommendations can be from a teacher, instructor, coach, community leader, religious leader, or supervisor who worked with the applicant, or any other adult (not a family member) who is familiar with applicant’s personal achievements and abilities. Completed recommendations should be:

- Returned to the student in a signed, sealed envelope for the student to include the recommendation with their completed application.

Due Date:

Completed applications for the Salvation Army Brooklyn Brownsville Corps “Helping Hand” Grant must be received by **Friday, May 15, 2026**. Any applications received after the deadline will be considered void and not considered by the review committee.

From the pool of applications received, applicants may be selected to do an on-line interview with the selection committee. Interviews will take place in the month of May 2026. Advanced notice regarding the exact date will be provided.
