### CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Provides emergency assistance to Henry County residents in need. Food, gifts, and toys for children and families along with gifts of blankets for elderly are provided at Christmas. Hosts weekly worship services, Bible studies, youth programming, and character building. The building provides a heating and cooling station during extreme weather conditions. Additional events, giveaways, and activities are provided such as diaper giveaways, homeschool events, zumba classes, educational classes and an adult basketball league.

### SUMMER CARE AND LEARNING

Day camp provides local children with opportunities to develop, mentally, physically, spiritually, and emotionally. Weekly field trips with education to improve learning and decision-making skills that builds the children from being strangers to being friends and ending as a family with Christ centered environment. It makes this a very special time for youths to develop Christian morals.

### ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other treatment programs include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

### HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

700-acre camp near Bedford. Nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, challenge course, archery range and high-quality log cabins. Over 400 kids and senior adults from across Indiana participate every summer in various camps (STEM, music, art, military, age specific camps), focusing on the body, mind and spirit.

### BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the “teach a person to fish” component of our mission.

## STORY OF HOPE

Each summer, The Salvation Army of Henry County hosts an affordable day camp for children, teaching them about God's love for them. One summer many years ago, a brother and sister in kindergarten and first grade showed up to day camp. Beth, the corps administrator, quickly learned that they were homeless and their single mother was struggling to have enough money to feed them. Beth was so happy to be able to provide a nutritious meal and a safe space for these kids each and every day at camp. The brother and sister came back year after year, often still living in tough situations. Amid their circumstances, they gave their lives to Christ because of the love shown to them through The Salvation Army.

All grown up and working in a nearby factory, that young boy found his way back to The Salvation Army of Henry County. He said it was his safe place and knew he needed to go there. He explained that he had been making bad choices and was ready to rededicate his life to Jesus. Several weeks after talking with Beth and recommitting his life to the Lord, he made a big decision. He has now decided to join the air force to become a Chaplain so he can share the love and faith he has experienced with others.
