

# LOGANSPORT 360 LIFE CENTER

Provides emergency assistance for Cass County families facing economic challenges. Christmas Angel Tree provides toys, clothing, and food for children. Partnerships provide school supplies. Sponsors at-risk youth to Hidden Falls Camp. Weekly worship services, men's Bible study and senior services. Gym: soccer, pickleball, & basketball.

# THE LORD'S CUPBOARD & THE LORD'S TABLE

Offers meals weekdays and food pantry groceries for working families, the hungry, and the homeless, along with spiritual care and encouragement.

## **EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES**

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional, and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water, and financial assistance at crucial moments.

## **ADDICTION SERVICES**

Provides resources, referrals, and transportation for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other treatment programs include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

#### HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, high ropes course, archery range and log cabins. Over 600 kids from across Indiana participate every summer in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

## **BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY**

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the "teach a person to fish" component of our mission.

# STORY OF HOPE

Every day the free community meal at the Logansport Salvation Army feeds anywhere from 25-50 people, resulting in 8,461 meals being served to those in need in 2024. The community meal is provided every day by volunteers.

The kitchen volunteers began noticing that there were 4-5 houseless individuals who would begin lining up for the meal very early in the morning even though it did not get served until mid-day. The kitchen volunteers began bringing those individuals out a warm cup of coffee every day. The volunteers began to think, "we could do more." With the little resources available, the different volunteers each day began bringing in and making pastries and eggs first thing in the morning, in addition to prepping for the community meal. Major Marlys says "it is the little things that make the most difference in the world." The volunteers at the Logansport Corps, choose to do the little things every day and it is making a world of difference in the lives of the individuals who now get a cup of coffee and breakfast each morning.
