### CORPS COMMUNITY CENTER

Provides emergency assistance (food, utilities, rent) to Vigo County residents. Provides clothing, Christmas gifts and toys for kids, and back to school supplies. Hosts weekly worship services, Bible studies youth programming, and character building.

### SHELTER & HOUSING

The Salvation Army provides safe shelter for individuals and families experiencing homelessness, domestic violence, and human trafficking. Affordable housing options are offered to individuals, families, and seniors with limited resources who are seeking a stable environment.

### ADDICTION SERVICES

Provides resources for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling, spiritual guidance, and life skills to avoid relapse. The Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other treatment programs include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.

### EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers, and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional, and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water, and financial assistance at crucial moments.

### HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, high ropes course, archery, range, and log cabins. Over 400 kids and senior adults from across Indiana participate every summer in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

### PATHWAY OF HOPE

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and helping to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. The goal is to move from crisis to sufficiency. This is the "teach a person to fish" component of our mission.

## STORY OF HOPE

One cold January day, Eli found his way into the Terre Haute Salvation Army corps looking for help. Eli explained that he has autism and has trouble with loud noises. This was a real struggle because he was currently living with his aunt who had 3 young and loud children. Eli was no longer able to manage the stress that came along with that living situation. After talking with the case manager at the Terre Haute Corps, she decided Eli would be a great candidate for the Pathway of Hope (POH) Program.

By the time Eli was able to get back to the corps to enroll in POH, he was no longer living at his aunt's and was now couch surfing. Together, Eli and the case manager began the Pathway of Hope journey together. Through collaboration with other community resources, they were able to get Eli the resources he needed. One of the most influential organizations that the POH caseworker got Eli connected to was the Timothy House, which is a great housing option for young men. Through Eli's grandmother, community partners, and The Salvation Army of Terre Haute, they were able to get Eli's first month's rent paid. After that he had progressed far enough in the POH program that he was able to pay his own rent and was well on his way to excelling through the program and moving towards sufficiency.
